The course is open to students pursuing undergraduate and post graduate degree from any Indian University/college with a minimum of 50% score in the last examination they have appeared.

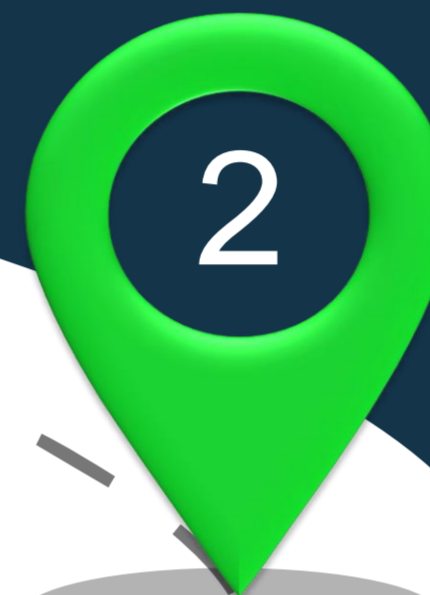
