Standard Operating Procedure

The following public health measures are to be followed to reduce the risk of COVID-19 by the students on account of opening of the College w.e.f. 17.02.2022:

- There will be mandatory thermal scanning followed by sanitising of hands for all students at the entry gate of the college. Students are advised to cooperate.
- All the students are advised to carry a copy of their vaccination certificates
- It is mandatory to wear a mask and carry a small sanitiser. No student will allowed to enter the college premises without a mask and a small sanitiser.
- Students are further advised to carry their own water bottle and food. They must avoid gathering around the water cooler.
- Students are advised not to loiter around in groups in corridors. They must adhere to all Covid protocols at all times.
- You are advised to maintain physical distancing of 6 feet while entering the college gate and at all times during your stay in college.
- Use of face covers/masks is mandatory at all times during you stay in the college.
- Frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty.
- Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing of used tissues properly.
- Self-monitoring of health by all is essential. You are advised to report any illness at the earliest to your teacher.
- Spitting is strictly prohibited in the college premises.
- Disposable substances such as disposable masks, gloves and other materials should be disposed individually with precautions.
- Sharing of eatables, books, other learning and reading material is not allowed.
- All students are required to strictly adhere to the DDMA guidelines issued from time to time.
