
**Strength:** The department has well qualified committed teachers with aspirations to achieve excellence. The department has been actively working with students to train them in linguistic skills, shloka-recitation, essay-writing, debate competitions, speech competitions and the students have been fetching us rewards, honors and victories to our full satisfaction. Through Panini grammar, the thinking skills and memory skills of the students are enhanced. Ayurveda and yoga-shastra included as the vital parts of the curriculum emphasize on how to keep one's physical, mental, emotional and psychological health in order in the present times.

**Weaknesses:** The general perception of the subject is not in the favour of attracting advanced students in good numbers. To overcome this, we need to familiarize people and prospective students with benefits Sanskrit can yield.

**Future Plans:** We plan to familiarize our students with some soft skills such as some practical/theoretical knowledge of manuscriptology, astronomy, acting, stress-management, Vedic Mathematics, Computational Sanskrit and Ayurveda. Soon, we hope to organize some special lectures/workshops on the above cited subjects.

**Challenges:** Sanskrit, being a classical language, may face declining interest among students due to perceptions of it being old or irrelevant in modern times. Students may find Sanskrit challenging due to their previous studies in the field of science and commerce. Graduates face limited job prospects directly related to Sanskrit, leading to concerns about the practical utility of pursuing the subject. Encouraging broader community engagement and interest in Sanskrit studies beyond the academic setting can be challenging but crucial for its continued relevance and preservation.
