

NCWEB REPORT 2016-17

Bharati College Non Collegiate Center marked an exciting and fun-filled academic session. The year was kick started with the Orientation Program for new students that was held at the center on 7th August 2016, the first day of the new academic session 2016-17. The new students were addressed by the Teacher in charge, Dr. Saloni Gupta and briefed about the various facets of college life at the center.

70th Independence Day of the nation was celebrated at the Bharati College NCWEB Center on 14th August 2016, 11 am onwards (during the break), in the central lawns at the unique initiative of the Teacher In Charge Dr. Saloni Gupta. On this occasion, she also announced a voluntary donation-based book bank for the students to an enthusiastic response by all the teachers of the centre who donated many of their personal books to the center for the benefit of the needy students.

A free of cost Yoga program was launched for the students and teachers of the center on 4th September 2016. It was led by experienced Yoga teachers and was conducted from 8 am to 9 am. The program was successful and attended by a large number of students.

An informative and interesting nukkad natak on Environment Conservation was presented jointly by students of Bharati College NCWEB students with the regular Students at "Udaan Utsav 2016", the Mega Nukkad Natak Competition organised from 20th to 22nd September 2016, with the eminent jury comprising Dr. Chandra Prakash Dwivedi, acclaimed Filmmaker Sudipta Sen, writer Advaita Kala, Singer Manoj Tiwari and others. Bharati College NCWEB Center was the only NCWEB Center to send in an entry.

A vibrant Fresher's Welcome was organised on 16th October 2016 with exciting competitions like the coveted "Miss Fresher", Singing competition, Poetry competition and Dance competition.

The Bharati College NCWEB Center teachers also registered their presence in the NCWEB get-together at Pratapgarh Resorts and Farms organised on 14th November 2016.

History teachers of NCWEB Bharati College Center organised an educational historical tour for History students on 21st December 2016, and visited Humayun's Tomb and Parliament museum.

Inter-Center competition was conducted on 1st January 2017 with interactive and creative activities like Fireless Cooking, Mehendi/Tattoo competition, Rangoli Competition, Mimicry Competition, On-the-spot Creative Writing, Short Skit competition and General Awareness Quiz. The competitions saw a lot of participation from students of various NCWEB centers and was thoroughly enjoyed by the students.

The Annual Sports Day event was organized on 19th February 2017 with many innovative and competitive sports competitions that were introduced for the first time. Games like Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Tug of War, 100 mtrs Race, Relay and Three-legged Race, Yoga, Sudoku, Chess and Throw Ball kept the students across classes and courses fully involved. Teachers and the non-teaching staff also participated in games organized for them.

A number of outreach and awareness generation programmes were conducted by the Centre by inviting dedicated Resource persons as part of the activities calendar of the Centre.

An Interactive Talk on Financial Literacy was organized on 27th December 2016 led by Dr. Seema Singh, Associate professor in Delhi Technological Institute with 75 students, and an innovative Block Printing Workshop was held on 21st December 2016 by Ms. Ritu Jain of Suunya Arts Studio. A three-day Personality Development workshop for the final year students of the center was organized from 17th to 19th March 2017, with various professional resource persons from the corporate sector.

Two students of Bharati NCWEB Himani and Shalu got best actor award in Nukkad Nataak competition held in Shyam Lal (Eve) College. Anshul and Smita got third prize in debate Competition in PGDAV college on 8th March 2017.
