


Feedback System


Q-8 How often IT enabled online teaching sessions was used by the teacher during lockdown?


Q-9 Teacher encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.






Q12 To what extent online teaching sessions during the lock down period was effective?




Is the governing body supportive?

Alumni Feedback Report 20-21

Alumni feedback has put an emphasis on the need for involvement of students in the quality assurance of higher education. The Alumni Committee at Bharati College always attempts to get a periodic and formative feedback from our former students that can provide a holistic assessment of our students' performance and evaluation of the existing practices, teaching learning activities and enhancement of skills in students. The objective of the feedback mechanism is to correctly gauge the impact of all the efforts taken by the institution on the development of students as professionals in the field of their choice. Bharati College aims to offer the best possible environment and learning experience to encourage students to perform to their full potential for academic achievement. The role and importance of alumni feedback is immense and helps the college to evaluate its policies and services and make changes as per the requirements of its stakeholders.

The reputation of an educational institution lies on its students. The reputation grows when an institution keeps producing successful graduates who become professionals in their fields. Therefore, the

alumni committee at Bharati College has been carrying out active engagement with their alumni and also maintains a database of its alumni. The alumni committee organizes events like an alumni meet every year to keep a track of the former students and their achievements.

Analysis of Alumni Feedback

- According to the feedback generated, on an average three out of ten students from the batch of 2018-2021, entered postgraduate university programmes in the same discipline that they graduated in. These disciplines include Commerce, Sanskrit, English, Sociology and History.
- Students also opted for with significantly higher entry rates in professional courses such as MBA and CFA.
- A significant number of students from the batch of 2018-2021, also entered vocationally-oriented programmes such as English Journalism and Tourism & Hospitality Management.

- Another performance indicator was students getting selected for positions such as Finance Analyst, Actuarial Analyst, Project & Community Manager, Academic Counsellor and Research Consultant in various well-known organizations such as HDFC Bank, KMPG India, MetLife GOSC, TATA AIA Life Insurance, Byjus, and AMICI Global Solutions Pvt Ltd.
- Overall, alumni feedback clearly depicts that students are well satisfied with the teaching methodology and the curriculum development in the college. Students were satisfied with guidance and mentoring by the teachers in the college.
- The students also appreciated the infrastructural facilities such library, seminar hall, theatre room, sports playground and other facilities.
- Majority of the alumni stated that they are satisfied that the college is able to maintain a fair balance between academics

and co-curricular activities.

- Another important suggestion from the Alumni has been to provide entrepreneurship opportunities to students and to organise professional seminars on skill and personality development.
- It was also observed from the feedback given by the alumni that
 few of them expressed the need of more ICT facilities in college.
 Hence, it is recommended to the college, to provide necessary
 ICT tools to the teachers as and when required to improve the
 ICT enabled learning in the college.

Recruiter Feedback Report-2020-21

During the academic year 2020-21, 14 companies visited the campus. A total of 79 students have sat for the campus placements. Out of this, only ten students were placed in 7 organisations.

In order to collect the feedback from the recruiters, mails were sent with feedback Google forms. In addition to this, calls were made by the faculty coordinator and cell students' representative to give reminders. Unfortunately, this year too, recruiters did not provide feedback despite repeated calls or emails. Later on, recruiters communicated over phone calls that they had experienced a smooth campus placement and found most applicants well equipped with skills. However, they have also suggested that they have witnessed a common trend in Bharati College and other college students, where students appear for the interviews to get the experience instead of getting the job. They pointed out that the above problem cannot be avoided entirely; however, some institutions impose strict guidelines to minimise such instances.

Keeping in mind the points raised by the recruiters, two major action plans were devised for the next academic year (2021-22). Firstly, to sharpen the skills of the Bharati college students, it was decided to organise a good number of training sessions by an external agency and student coordinators of Training and Placement Cell, Bharati College. Secondly, prepare and issue guidelines to make students more serious about the interview process.

Final Remarks

59% students think that the syllabus was majorly covered in the class and teachers were thoroughly prepared for the class in terms of concepts almost 55% teachers used IT enabled techniques for online teaching and 50% students believe that their performance as a teacher was excellent. Almost 70% students have given a feedback that their teaching sessions were very effective during lockdown. 66% student consider communications from the teachers effective. Teachers illustrate the concepts through examples.

Action Taken Report

Reports of feedback from students for the teachers were compiled and shared with the concerned persons by the principal. Principal personally called the teachers who have been appreciated by students for teaching in such unprecedented situation and congratulated them for their outstanding performance. The grievances related to a few teachers have been personally taken care of by calling upon them and asking them to be careful in future. The administrative officer has also been apprised of the student's feedback and has been asked to be inform his staff to be careful in dealing with the students. Additionally, specifically keeping the pandemic in mind, students expressed dissatisfaction with the online mode of instruction, desiring for syllabus and consequently screen time to be reduced, classes to be made more engaging, notes and lecture recordings to be made available, and logistical issues faced by them to be acknowledged and addressed appropriately. Due to staggered semesters and other difficulties mentioned above, students have shown their willingness for physical

mode and considered it as a better way to learn the teaching outcomes. The pandemic has been an unprecedented and unforeseen intrusion into the normal life of collegiate teaching. Online classes are only a temporary measure to ensure the utmost safety of our students without allowing a gap in their education. When demands for reduced screen time were raised, a decision to reformulate class timings was taken and that there are short breaks between classes so that students may rest their eyes .
