Inauguration of composting site along with and interactive and educational seminar for students. A training session was organized specifically for the house keeping staff.



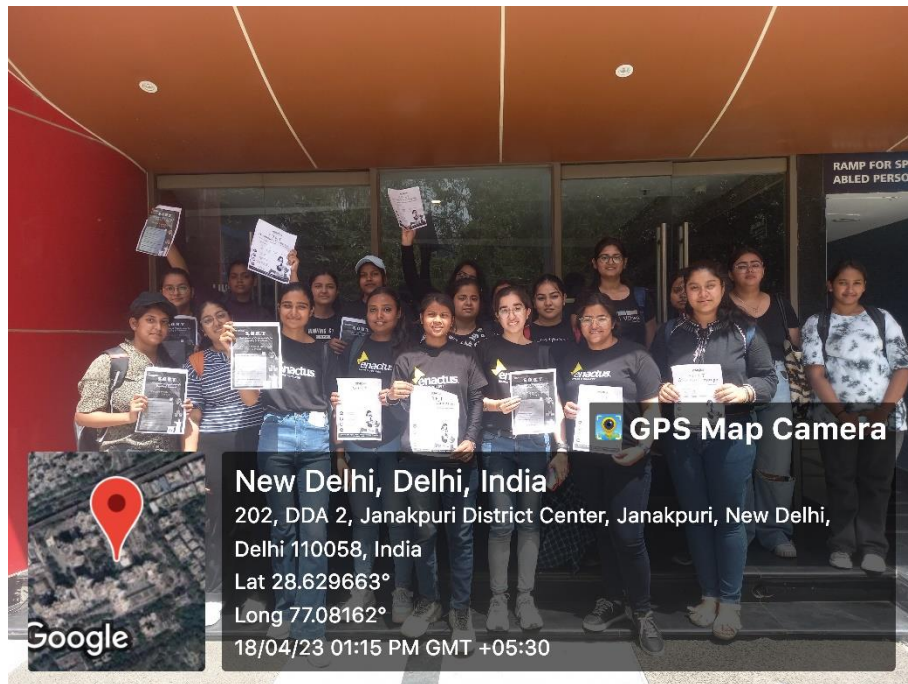
DAY 2

PROJECT NOOR



Enactus Bharati launched its project Noor on 10th April 2023 as a big step towards employment of unrecognized and backward women. The project aimed to provide employment to needy and unemployed women of backward regions who don't have the resources. Enactus Bharati generated employment by getting different types of diaries handcrafted by such women and selling them at their fest.

OUR MISSION

The main objective of Project Noor was to empower women by providing them with a platform to showcase their talent and generate employment for them. Enactus Bharati aimed to bring a positive change in the lives of women from backward regions and help them achieve financial independence.

OUR STORY

Enactus Bharati's project Noor was a result of the hard work of the entire team. The project was launched to support the cause of women empowerment and provide opportunities to the underprivileged women to showcase their talent. The team worked tirelessly to get different types of diaries handcrafted by these women and sold them at their fest. The project was a big success and helped in generating employment for many women.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

OPERATIONS

- Project Noor got started in February 2023. The idea of this project was founded in the month of February. Where we thought of taking an initiative towards the employment of unrecognized and backward communities of women, to also showcase their artistic talents.
- Research of project Noor started with finding women communities who were engaged in handicrafts and handmade arts.
- Research was conducted on the current pricings of these handcrafted materials. We went to different shops mainly in Janakpuri and Dwarka to gather the idea of the price range which is going on today and according to that we finalized the prices.
- We got in touch with the women communities and the NGOs who were associated with women and their empowerment. We made them understand the whole process and objective of the project Noor. Collaboration was done with these communities and NGOs.
- After the whole process of researching we finally took a step towards the making of these handcrafted diaries. We collected all the raw material that was required for the making of products and was provided to the makers.
- We started with the making of the products which included the creation of diaries from scratch. Artwork was done by the women we collaborated with and the whole process of making and finalizing the products was done.
- We also started with the process of packaging. All the products got ready for packaging, and we got them packaged. The packaging process took 3 days, and it was done through and through.

- Our project Noor goes launched on 10th of April as on this day we put up the stall in our college fest.

Shaina, from one such acid attack community was invited to do the honour at our stall. All the diaries and jhumkas were packed nicely and placed on the stall.



- The Enactus team was there to sell the products
- Shaina, (acid attack survivor), their brand ambassador arrived and was felicitated with a hamper and a bouquet.



- Principal of Bharati college, Ms. Saloni Gupta, was also present and contributed to the success of this project.
- She bought a pair of jhumkas and a diary in respect of those women who handcrafted them.
