- **Brief history of the College**

Bharati College, a premier and prestigious college for women, was established as a constituent college with permanent affiliation to the University of Delhi by Delhi Administration on 20th September 1971 as Bharati Mahila College. The College started functioning from the premises of a Government Senior Secondary School for Boys located on the Link Road in Karol Bagh. A modest number of two hundred and forty-one students and a team of thirteen teaching staff spread over six disciplines formed the building bloc. In 1998, the college started operating from its new location. Situated in an eco-friendly environment, it possesses 23 classrooms, 46 tutorial rooms, a seminar and conference room, a studio theatre and 3 Computer Labs with over 120 computers. The new building in the campus with 26 rooms, 2 labs and a staff room has been a welcome addition to the College.
