PROJECT S.O.R.T

SEGREGATION OF ORGANIC WASTE FOR RECYCLING AND TREATMENT

Enactus and IQAC, Bharati College in collaboration with IPCA (Indian Pollution control association), took the initiative with starting the project SORT to create awareness for the waste management in the college campus and nearby areas. Under the project two composter were installed in the college campus to segregate the waste. The inauguration ceremony of this project was held on 14th Feb'23, where the composters were inaugurated by IAS Shri Kumar Abhishek, Commissioner, MCD west zone. After the inauguration training session was also organised for housekeeping staff of canteen, hostel mess and other staff. A street play was organised for the students, teaching and non-teaching staff of college. An awareness workshop was also organised with pre collected data of students which was addressed by Dr Radha Goyal, IPCA and Mr. Deepankar on solid waste and E-Waste management. Awareness campaign was also run by students in college campus to spread the awareness. With constant supervision and efforts, we got good quality manure for campus plants and for sales purpose. This project has also started taking waste from nearby cafes to spread the awareness. A small garden is also prepared under it. Inspection visit was also held from IPCA. Campaign organized to spread awareness regarding Project S.O.R.T. Members visited nearby residential areas, parks and cafes and educated the crowd present. Highlights of projects were as follows

PROJECT NOOR

Enactus Bharati launched its project Noor on 10th April 2023 as a big step towards employment of unrecognized and backward women. The project aimed to provide employment to needy and unemployed women of backward regions who don't have the resources. Enactus Bharati generated employment by getting different types of diaries handcrafted by such women and selling them at their fest.

Project Noor got started in February 2023. We thought of taking an initiative towards the employment of unrecognized and backward communities of women, to also showcase their artistic talents. Research of project Noor started with finding women communities who were engaged in handicrafts and handmade arts. We got in touch with the women communities and the NGOs who were associated with women and their empowerment. We made them understand the whole process and objective of the project Noor. Collaboration was done with these communities and NGOs. We collected all the raw material that was required for the making of products and was provided to the makers. We started with the making of the products which included the creation of diaries from scratch. Artwork was done by the women we collaborated with and the whole process of making and finalizing the products was done. We also started with the process of packaging. The packaging process took 3 days, and it was done through and through. Our project Noor goes launched on 10th of April as on this day we put up the stall in our college fest. Shaina, from one such acid attack community was invited to do the honour at our stall. All the diaries and jhumkas were packed nicely and placed on the stall.

The Enactus team was there to sell the products. Shaina, (acid attack survivor), their brand ambassador arrived and was felicitated with a hamper and a bouquet. Principal of Bharati college, Ms.Saloni Gupta, was also present and contributed to the success of this project. She bought a pair of jhumkas and a diary in respect of those women who handcrafted them. Project Noor was also promoted at the annual fest of Maharaja Agrasen College.



EVENTS AND DRIVES

AE HALO- GARBA EVENT

The newly formed Enactus Team, organized Ae Halo- a garba event during Navratri 2022. The team invited local small-scale vendors to display their products and sell them at the event. The idea was to give small scale vendor a platform to display their products. The event was organized after a hiatus of 2 years due to Covid-19 and was attended by hundreds of college students, attributing to its success.

Short L and E report 2021-23

36 students benefitted in 2021-22 and 51 students in 2022-23 under the Fee Waiver/ Learn and Earn scheme. A sum of Rs 3,36,530 was paid to them in 2021-2022 and Rs.5,49,395 was paid in 2022-23.

4 students from Learn and Earn working with the alumni and the GB member Mr.Lokesh Parashar for the Alumni Data preparation received Rs 8,100 in 2022-23.

The college stepped up to help the students hit hard during the Pandemic. On 22nd October 2021 it was decided that the students whose parent/s expired due to Covid will get full fee reimbursement. One student was the beneficiary in this case. 4 other students also received full fee reimbursement whose parent/s had passed away not due to Covid but who were in dire circumstances due to lack of resources. Another 40 students were given 50 percent fee- waiver.

On 29th Oct 2021, the committee recommended the names of 4 students from amongst the Learn and Earn/Fee Waiver scheme whose annual family income was the lowest for Ms Usha Khattar Scholarship. In 2022, 7 students were recommended for the same.

On Dec 1 2022, 10 applicants out of 27 were shortlisted to be interviewed by Mr.Ashish Jindal and his team for Manohar cum means scholarship for the first time. The Umrao Trust that funds this scholarship is run by Mr.Ashish Jindal, son of a former colleague from Bharati College. Another 11 students were recommended in 2023.

These 2 scholarships are new to the College and is being handled by the Fee Waiver /Learn and Earn Committee.

10 students were recommended for Learn and Earn in 2023 to work in the library, administration and Sports sections.

The Committee recommends the following:

1.To make it clear to the students that Learn and Earn is not an ordinary scholarship, one more column should be added to the Learn and Earn form where the students take an undertaking that they will work for a fixed number of hours in the library/administration or any other section of the college as decided by the Committee.

2.A consent form for deduction in salary be taken out each year in July so that the willing teaching and non-teaching staff can sponsor students' education. The smallest contribution can be Rs 500 a month for 1 year.

3. For greater transparency and clarity, one member from the Accounts section should join the Committee so that financial matters can be discussed properly.
