


DEPARTMENT OF JOURNALISM

Since its inception, the Department of Journalism has engaged in discourse pertaining to the evolving media space. In the academic year 2022-2023, Tarseel, the departmental society of Journalism further attempted to provide academic and practical exposure to students by conducting debates, discussions, movie screenings, seminars, and workshops primarily focusing on the media industry and different facets of politics, society, gender, culture, etc. throughout the year. Tarseel achieved numerous successes and implemented several initiatives to promote academic excellence and collaboration.

The following activities/ events were organised by the department in the academic year 2022-2023:

DOCUMENTARY SCREENING - WRITING WITH FIRE [Link](#)

On July 25, 2022, the Department of Journalism held a documentary screening of “Writing with Fire” directed by Rintu Thomas and Sushmit Ghosh. A double Sundance winner, “Writing with Fire” was nominated for an Academy Award for Best Feature Documentary, making it the first Indian feature documentary to be nominated for an Oscar.

Meera Devi, Shyamkali Devi, and Suneeta Prajapati were the women protagonists in the film. In a cluttered news landscape dominated by men, emerged India's only newspaper run by Dalit women. Armed with smartphones, Chief Reporter Meera and her journalists break traditions, be it on the frontlines of India's biggest issues or within the confines of their homes,

redefining what it means to be powerful. The documentary elaborated upon the only newspaper in India that was run by Dalit women - Khabar Lahariya. It inspired every student in the field of Journalism to introspect.





PHOTO STORY CONTEST [Link](#)


SPEECH COMPETITION [Link](#)


PANEL DISCUSSION - MEDIA OBJECTIVITY, MYTH OR REALITY [Link](#)


Visit to India Tv Broadcast Centre [Link](#)




