Summary of the event:

In order to familiarize the students group discussion and enhance the chances of selection of students, the session was opened by Ms. Ayushi Taneja and Ms. Shruti Aggarwal (Student Coordinators, Training and Placement Cell, Bharati College). Ms. Taneja started the session by giving a brief about importance of group discussion in selection process for a student's aspiring for higher studies or dream job. And thereafter, she started interacting with students to know about their understanding of key skills for GD. She also asked everyone to work on communication skills. She ended the session by offering thanks for active participation.
