Summary of the event:

Mr. Brij started the session by giving a brief about importance of group discussion in selection process for a students aspiring for higher studies or dream job. And thereafter, he started interacting with students to know about their understanding of key skills for GD. On the basis of input received, Mr. Brij highlighted various key aspect that a should student keep in mind while appearing for the group discussion. He has also informed the students about benefit of using facts and quotes during the GD can increase their chance of selection. He further expalin to students about various roles a participant can play during the GD (e.g., initiater, moderator, follower, trouble maker etc.).
