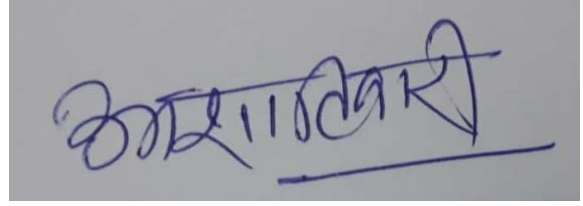


Report of the Talk on Science and Technology in Sanskrit Literature

The department of Sanskrit organized a talk on “Science and Technology in Sanskrit Literature” on 14th November, 2019. It was delivered by the former ISRO scientist Prof Om Prakash Pandey and Prof Ram Nath Jha of Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. Prof Pandey talked about various movements of earth and its references in Vedic literature. He also deliberated upon the phenomenon of global warming and its timing in different periods of time. Prof Ram Nath Jha narrated some real life stories of some Indian scientists, Gurudev Rabindra Nath Tagore and Einstein. He very well connected the modern science with the Vedantic philosophy. Jagdish Chandra Bose, Satyendra Nath Bose and their contribution in the Higgs-Boson particle (God particle) were discussed. He also threw light on the concept of consciousness available in animate and non-animate objects.
