

Bharati College has a Rainwater Harvesting system with Bore well recharge at the College campus since 30th August, 2003 at old building. The Vigyan Vijay Foundation constructed the rainwater harvesting system as per guidelines of Delhi Jal Board. Three Rainwater Harvesting Structures are there in the college premises one is **Adjacent to main college block near main gate, another Rainwater Harvesting structure is at corner near the smaller gate and the third structure is at the extreme corner near C4D block.** Because of RWH structures the water table has increased by 6"-7" in comparison to neighboring areas. The quality of water, has also improved.

More RWH structures are proposed near the new building and its construction is under progress.
