OUR AIM:

Through this event, NSS Bharati aimed to commemorate the values and courageousness of our freedom fighter Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, also known as the Iron Man of India, on his 147th birth anniversary.

OUR PHILOSOPHY:

Vallabhbhai Jhaverbhai Patel was an Indian lawyer, influential political leader and statesman who served as the first Deputy Prime Minister and first Home Minister of India from 1947 to 1950. He is known for his role in the peaceful integration of the princely states to the Indian union.
