ABOUT OUR ARTISTS

Dr. Neeta Pandey Negi holds a BA and MA in Music from Miranda House, University of Delhi, along with an MPhil and PhD from Delhi University's Music Department. Trained in Kirana and Dilli Gharanas under Charanjeet Soni Ji and Ustad Iqbal Ahmed Khan Saheb, she has appeared on national and international reality shows like Indian Idol and Rising Star. Since 2008, she has performed with her Sufi jugalbandi band, Roohani Sisters, which was empanelled by ICCR in 2009.



Syed Sahil Agha is an acclaimed Indian storyteller specializing in Dastangoi, a traditional form of oral narrative. His works span biographical accounts of notable figures, including the book Dastan-e-Hind—a collection of Indian dastans and folklores—that has been performed by artists worldwide. Agha rediscovered the ancient art of “QissaKhawani” and revived it as “QissaGoi.” He scripted and wrote dialogues for Ghalib Umrao Begum, telecast on DD Urdu, and organized India's largest oral storytelling series in collaboration with Vestige Marketing, earning widespread success.
