Annual Report 2024-25

NEP Saarthi, Bharati College, has been instrumental in promoting awareness and understanding of the National Education Policy (NEP) through a variety of activities conducted in 2024. In April, NEP Saarthi held a comprehensive NEP Lecture designed to introduce the attendees to the main objectives and goals of the National Education Policy. This event was crucial in familiarizing participants with the fundamental changes that NEP brings to India's education system, including the shift towards holistic education, interdisciplinary learning, and the incorporation of new pedagogies. The lecture saw active participation, and the attendees, including students and faculty members, were able to ask questions and engage in meaningful discussions. The session not only increased awareness but also motivated individuals to think critically about how NEP would affect education in India and their role in its implementation. Additionally, NEP Saarthi installed an NEP photo booth on the college campus. This creative addition served as an interactive way to draw attention to the policy. The booth featured informative posters, key highlights of NEP, and a space for students to click photos and share their for the initiative on social media, thereby amplifying support its outreach.

Moving to August, NEP Saarthi organized a workshop on NEP Awareness at Sarvodaya Bal Vidyalaya, a school that caters to students from various backgrounds. This workshop was a handson approach to understanding NEP, and it involved a range of interactive sessions that were designed to simplify complex topics in the policy. Through presentations, group discussions, and activities, the participants gained a deeper understanding of NEP's vision and its implications on the educational landscape. The workshop also provided a platform for teachers and students to discuss the challenges and opportunities that NEP presents, as well as ways to effectively integrate these changes into the existing education system. In October, NEP Saarthi took a more creative approach to spread awareness by organizing a nukkad natak (street play) to engage the public in a more informal and impactful manner. The performance, conducted by the Manthan: The Natak Society of Bharati College. This street play was staged in different community spaces, reaching a diverse audience beyond the academic setting. Through the power of drama and street theater, the play dramatized the key elements of NEP, addressing its core message about educational reforms, student-centered learning, and the importance of inclusivity in education. The use of street theater was especially effective in reaching individuals who might not have been engaged in formal workshops or lectures but were still able connect with the message through the creative medium of performance. These events have not only educated participants about the principles of NEP but have also provided platforms for dialogue, discussion, and creative expression.
